COST OF ATTENDANCE

BILLING INFORMATION

Each semester students are required to pay their balance before the term starts. Fall bills are due by July 27th, 2019. Spring bills are due by January 4th, 2020. Summer bills are due May 17th, 2020. MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN - Not available until May 2020
